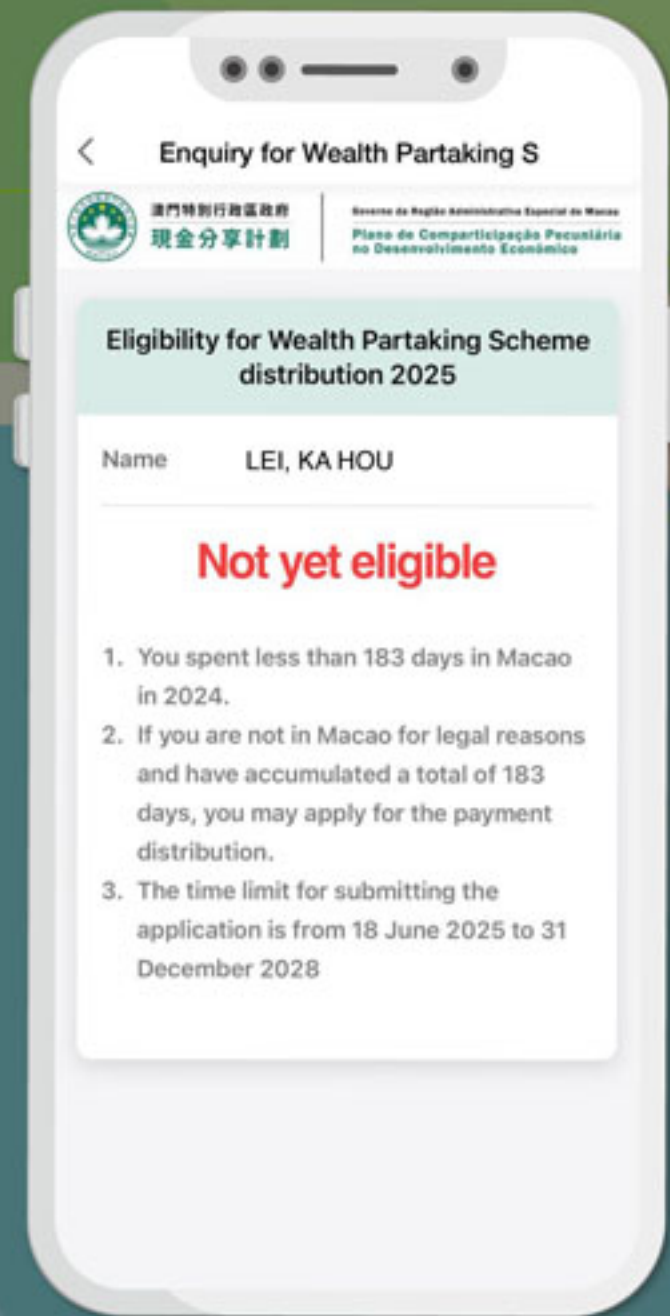

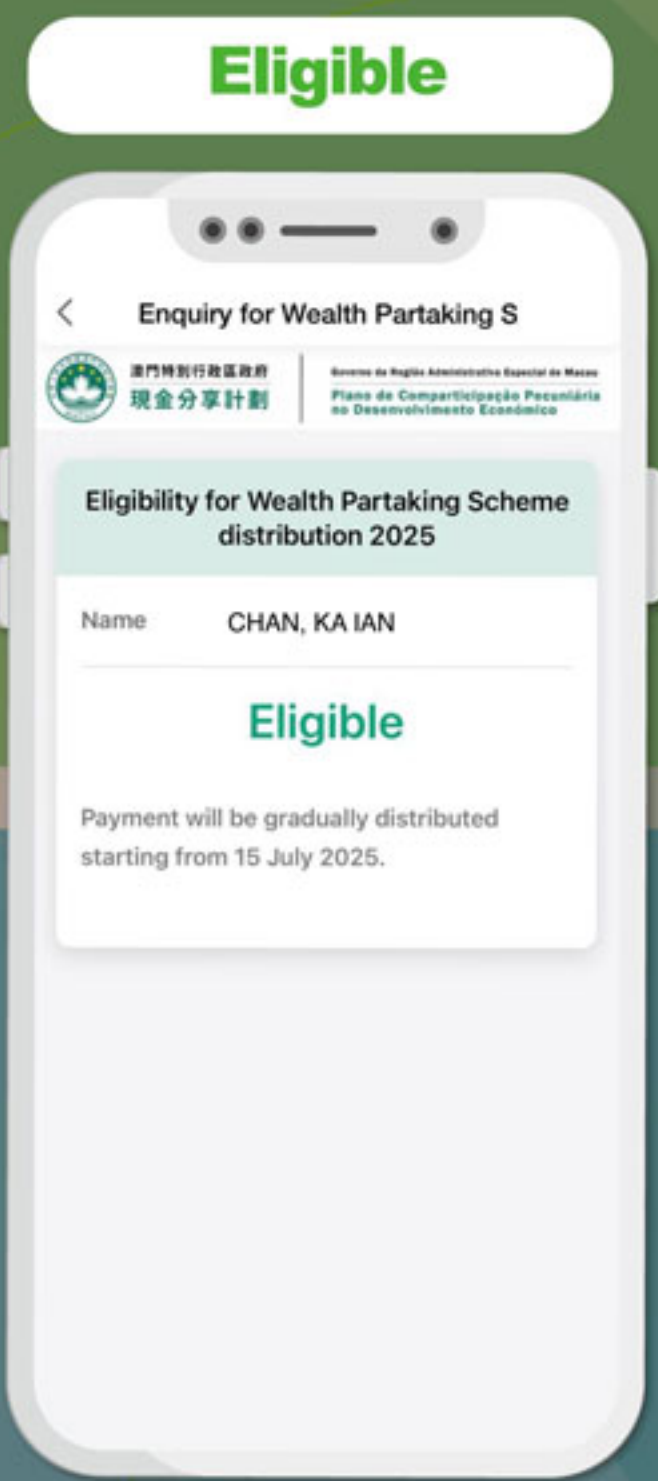
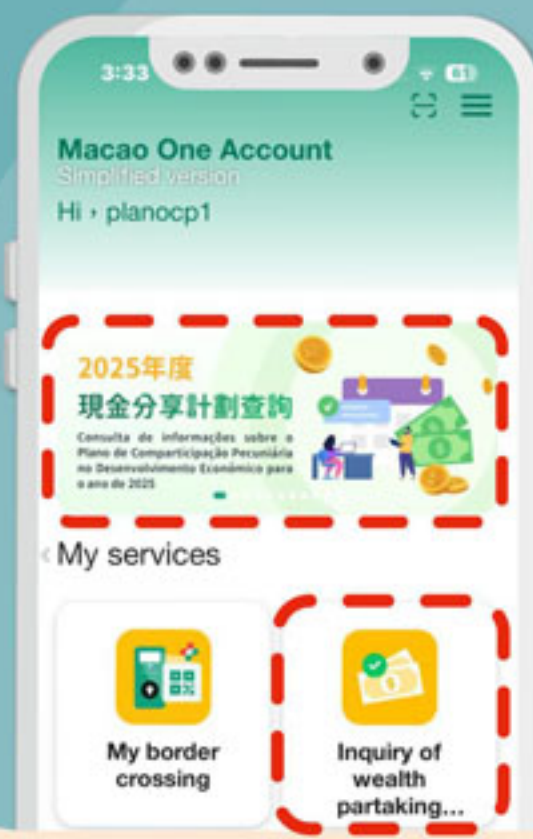
Traditional version of the Macao One Account



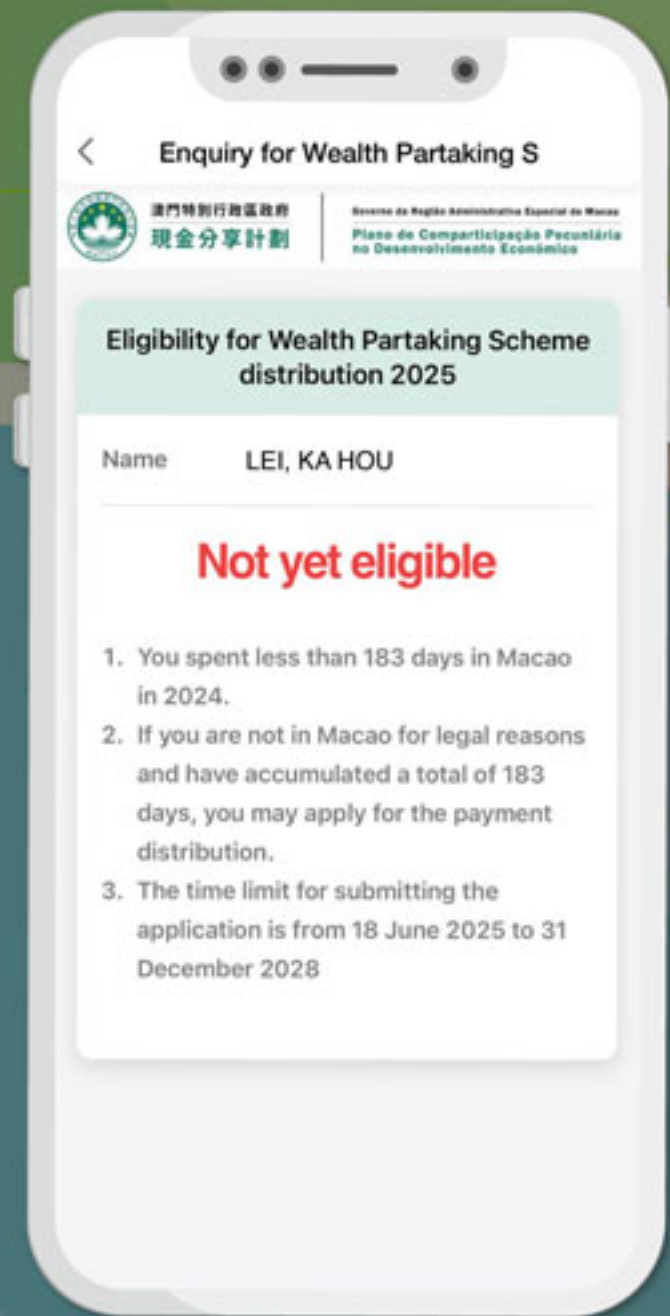
